FLYING FARMERS CHICKEN SALAD

Ingredients:

3 Cups Cooked Rice
2 Tbsp. Salad Oil
1 ½ Cups Green Grapes
2 Tbsp. Orange Juice
1 ½ Cups Sliced Celery
2 Tbsp. Vinegar
1 (11oz) Can Mandarin Oranges
1 tsp. Salt
1 Cup Toasted Almonds
¾ Cup Mayonnaise
1 (13 ½ oz) Can Pineapple Tidbits
¾ Cup Miracle Whip
5 cups Cooked Diced Chicken

Directions:

Mix together salad oil, orange juice, vinegar, salt, mayonnaise and miracle whip (you can omit the mayo or m. whip if you like or use 1 ½ cups of either) in a bowl. Add chicken to mixture above. Let stand while preparing other ingredients. Gently toss together all ingredients. It is best when served after being chilled over night.

Stonewater has many runners and walkers! Here are a few distance measurements within Stonewater:

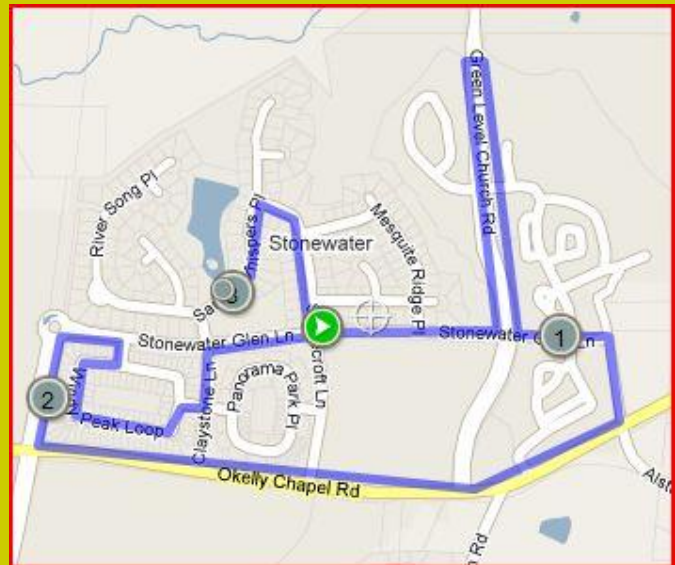
Bali Loop: .46 miles

HOW TO KEEP YOUR BERMUDA GRASS GREEN

Water to a soil depth of 4 to 6 inches. Probe with a screwdriver to determine moisture depth. Bermuda grasses need a weekly application of about 1" of water. On sandy soils it often requires more frequent watering, for example, 1/2 inch of water every third day. It is often necessary to irrigate an area for 3 to 5 hours to apply 1 inch of water. (It requires 640 gallons of water to deliver 1 inch of water per thousand square feet.) Because clay soils accept water slowly, irrigate just until runoff occurs, wait 1/2 hour until the water has been absorbed, and then continue irrigating until the desired depth or amount is obtained. A dark bluish gray color, foot-printing, and wilted, folded, or curled leaves indicate that it is time to water. Proper irrigation may prevent or reduce pest problems and environmental stress later in the summer.

TOWN OF CARY WATERING DAYS

Even Address: Wednesday, Friday & Sunday

No automated watering devices allowed on Mondays.

Odd Address: Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday

Drip irrigation and watering by hand (with cans, wands, hand-held hoses) is allowed any day of the week. You must actually be holding the watering hose, can, etc. Watering by hand cannot occur unattended.

Exceptions

Washing of cars, driveways, houses, etc. - Watering restrictions do not apply.

A 45-day exception to the alternate day rule is available for establishing new grass and for seasonal reseeded. Registration is required.

Use of reclaimed water, well water or ponds - Watering restrictions do not apply.
